The NT Government, through the Town Camps Futures Unit, is investing in generational change for Territorians living in town camps.



HOUSING AND INFRASTRUCTURE IN TOWN CAMPS


\$15.6 million has been spent on housing and infrastructure



79 proposed housing upgrades


78% of housing upgrades have been completed


93% of additional bedrooms and/or living spaces completed


6 unsafe/derelict dwellings have been demolished


60% of new kitchens have been completed


880 lineal metres of water lines have been replaced



86% of new ablution facilities have been completed

48 local suppliers and contractors have been engaged


7 Aboriginal Business Enterprises have been contracted to deliver services


63 Aboriginal employees have worked on projects


24 Aboriginal Employees have been employed on or after the commencement of projects
